CHAPTER 39

An Act to Amend the Dietitians Act

(Assented to December 3, 2008)

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. Section 1 of the *Dietitians Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. D-10.1 is amended by the repeal of clause (c).

2. Section 6 of the Act is amended

(a) in clause (3)(a), by the deletion of the words “, and fees for registration”; and

(b) by the addition of the following after subsection (3):

(4) The Board may make, amend and revoke bylaws, not inconsistent with this Act, relating to the management and operation of the Board, including bylaws respecting

(a) the election or appointment, terms of office, duties and remuneration of officers of the Board;

(b) the calling and conduct of meetings of the Board;

(c) the establishment and operation of committees of the Board;

(d) the making, amendment and revocation of bylaws of the Board; and

(e) the fees that are payable for

(i) the examination, registration and issuance of an initial certificate to an applicant seeking to be registered as a dietitian under subsection 10(3),

(ii) the issuance of a special limited certificate to an applicant seeking to be registered as a dietitian under section 12,

(iii) an annual renewal of a certificate under clause 15(2)(c), and

(iv) the renewal of a lapsed registration and the penalty for late annual renewal of a certificate under subsection 16(2).

3. Subsection 10(3) of the Act is amended by the deletion of the words “and paid the prescribed fee” and the substitution of the words “and paid the examination fee, if any, and the fee for registration and the issuance of an initial certificate established by the bylaws”.

4. Section 12 of the Act is amended by addition of the words “and upon payment of the fee established by the bylaws” after the word “conditions”.

5. Clause 15(2)(c) of the Act is amended by the deletion of the words “prescribed renewal fee” and the substitution of the words “renewal fee established by the bylaws”.

6. Subsection 16(2) of the Act is amended by the deletion of the words “the fee paid” and the substitution of the words “the fee for renewal of a lapsed registration and the penalty for late annual renewal of a certificate established by the bylaws are paid”.

7. This Act comes into force on a date that may be fixed by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
