CHAPTER 44

An Act to Amend the Financial Administration Act (No. 3)

(Assented to December 3, 2008)

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. Subsection 61(1) of the *Financial Administration Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. F-9 is repealed and the following substituted:

61. (1) The Comptroller shall prepare a report called the Public Accounts for each fiscal year. Public Accounts, preparation

(1.1) Where a fixed-date general election is to be held in the month of October next following the end of a fiscal year, the Provincial Treasurer shall file the Public Accounts prepared by the Comptroller for that fiscal year with the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly on or before August 31 next following the end of that fiscal year. Filing Public Accounts with Clerk of Legislative Assembly before fixed-date general election

(1.2) Where a fixed-date general election is not to be held in the month of October next following the end of a fiscal year, the Provincial Treasurer shall lay the Public Accounts prepared by the Comptroller for that fiscal year before the Legislative Assembly Submission of Public Accounts to Legislative Assembly where no fixed-date election

- (a) on or before January 31 next following the end of that fiscal year; or
- (b) if the Legislative Assembly is not in session on that date, within fifteen sitting days following the commencement of the next ensuing session.

(1.3) The Clerk of the Legislative Assembly shall make any Public Accounts filed with the Clerk pursuant to subsection (1.1) available for inspection by any person, without charge, during normal business hours. Public Accounts to be available for inspection before fixed-date general election

(1.4) In this section, “fixed-date general election” means a general election held pursuant to subsection 4.1(2) of the *Election Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-1.1. fixed-date general election, defined
