An Act to Amend the Crown Proceedings Act

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant Governor and the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. The *Crown Proceedings Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. C-32* is amended by the addition of the following after section 17:

17.1 (1) For the purposes of this section, “Agreement on Internal Trade” means the Agreement on Internal Trade entered into by the governments of Canada, the provinces, the Northwest Territories and the Yukon Territory in 1994, as amended from time to time.

(2) Where a presiding body under the Agreement on Internal Trade has made an order against the Crown for a monetary penalty or for Tariff Costs under Article 1706.1(4)(b), 1706.1(6), 1707(11)(b), 1707.2(1) 1707.2(6) or 1716(3) of the Agreement, a certified copy of the order made by the presiding body may be filed with the Supreme Court and, on being filed, the order has the same force and effect as an order for the payment of money or costs made by the court against the Crown.

Enforcement of
orders

2. This Act comes into force on June 30, 2010.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 allows for orders under the Agreement on Internal Trade to be filed in the P.E.I. Supreme Court, as orders for payment of money or costs, and to be enforceable as if they were orders of the Supreme Court. The section also provides a definition for Agreement on Internal Trade.

SECTION 2 provides for the commencement of this Act.
