## Information requested of Minister Currie

To be tabled December 7, 2016

### Museums - \$150,000 annually for 5 years (James Aylward, Steven Myers)

In 2016-17, the main project is repairing the roof and structure of both Beaconsfield House and the Carriage House. This will use most of the budget this year. In 2017-18, the priority project is upgrades to the Orwell site.

Education, Early Learning and Culture is working with the federal government on potential cost sharing opportunities at museum sites to make our \$150,000 stretch further. (Peter Bevan-Baker)

### Music Instruments(Brad Trivers)

Music instruments are purchased through the Public Schools Branch operating budget for equipment, not the Education, Early Learning and Culture capital budget.

### Records Center Expansion (Steven Myers)

The new storage site will be at Slemon Park. Government is leasing the space from Slemon Park, so it is included in Transportation, Infrastructure and Energy's operating budget for building leases, not in the Education, Early Learning and Culture capital budget. As part of the lease agreement, Slemon Park is performing the fit-up required to the space.
