Information for Private Members Bill -- An Amendment to the Highway Traffic Act

MLA is seeking to increase the minimum fine for not stopping for a school bus when their lights are flashing from \$1,000 to \$2,000.

- I think this would be something that should be discussed with our partners including justice and law enforcement before we make such a change.
- Prince Edward Island already has the highest fines in Canada for failing to stop for a school bus when their red lights are flashing.
- Additionally, Graduated Drivers in Stage 1 and 2 of PEI's GDL Program have their driver licenses suspended for 30 days if convicted of this offence.
