QUESTION: Please provide a list of the condition and status of all harbours in Prince Edward Island and a copy of reports from the federal department of Fisheries and Oceans.

ANSWER:

The Department of Agriculture and Fisheries does not have ownership of the core fishing harbours in Prince Edward Island. The responsibility for ongoing repair and capital upgrade is under the Small Crafts and Harbours Division of the Department of Fisheries and Oceans and Canadian Coast Guard. Small Crafts and Harbours Division in PEI works collaboratively with each Harbour Authority that operate the business of the harbours. Every harbor has a volunteer board of directors' made up of mostly commercial fishers in that harbour. This board is referred to a Harbour Authority.

We contacted the Department of Fisheries and Oceans for a list of the condition and status of all harbours and they had no information to share.
