QUESTION: Please provide the 2019-2024 power purchase agreement between Maritime Electric Company Limited and New Brunswick Power that was referenced by the Minister of Transportation, Infrastructure and Energy in The Guardian on 29 October 2018.

ANSWER:

The Province is not signatory to this agreement and therefore does not have a signed copy. This agreement is a private agreement between New Brunswick Energy Marketing (NBEM) and Maritime Electric Company Limited (MECL). Under section 12.2 of the Electric Power Act, MECL was obligated to involve the PEI Energy Corporation (PEIEC) in the negotiations for the supply of electric energy but details are subject to a non-disclosure agreement due to proprietary pricing and business information.
