QUESTION: [Please provide] a list of all funding given to the Lakeside Beach boardwalk.

ANSWER:

- October 2017 A grant through the Community Development Program (CDP) was provide to Morell and Area Development Corporation for the removal of the stairs at Lakeside Beach due to them being damaged and considered unsafe. Total project costs \$4376, CDP contribution was \$2,188.
- July 2010 A grant was provided through the Island Community Fund (ICF)for a repairs to Lakeside Beach boardwalk. Total project cost \$23,467, ICF contribution \$17,600
- July 2005 A grant was provided through EMO Disaster relief of \$13,948 for repairs to the boardwalk in Lakeside.
