ANSWER:

Gemalto Canada Inc. is the company contracted to provide new drivers licenses for PEI and the 3 other Atlantic Provinces.

The client will receive their driver license within 14 business days from the date the driver license is processed at any Access PEI location.

Please note, a driver's license can be renewed up to 5 months prior to the expiry date without any additional cost to the driver.

QUESTION: What form of temporary license is provided to the client until receipt of the new drivers license is received?

ANSWER:

When a new driver license is processed or renewed at any Access PEI office, the computer system used by motor vehicle offices across the country and by local police is updated simultaneously to show the driver has a valid and existing driver license.

A temporary paper document valid for 30 days is produced for the driver and meets the standards as recommended for Interim/Temporary Drive Licenses as published by the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA). This document contains the driver's basic information (name, date of birth, address, class of license, expiry and any conditions and/or restrictions on the driver's license.

All Canadian jurisdictions are members of AAMVA.

Additionally, the driver retains their existing or expired driver license as a further piece of identification.
