I am writing today to draw your attention of a number of allegations made against the Green Party in the Legislative Assembly during Question Period yesterday concerning the unauthorized sharing of personal data. I have included a transcript of the exchange for your reference.

The Green Party is deeply concerned about these allegations, which we believe are unfounded. We are requesting that Elections PEI conduct an investigation to ascertain the basis of these allegations and provide the party with an opportunity to refute these serious charges.

Considering the potential damage that any misinformation might inflict on the public's perception of Prince Edward Island's electoral integrity, I hope you will be able to give this matter your immediate attention.

We are also writing to the Information and Privacy Commissioner to request that she conduct a parallel investigation.
