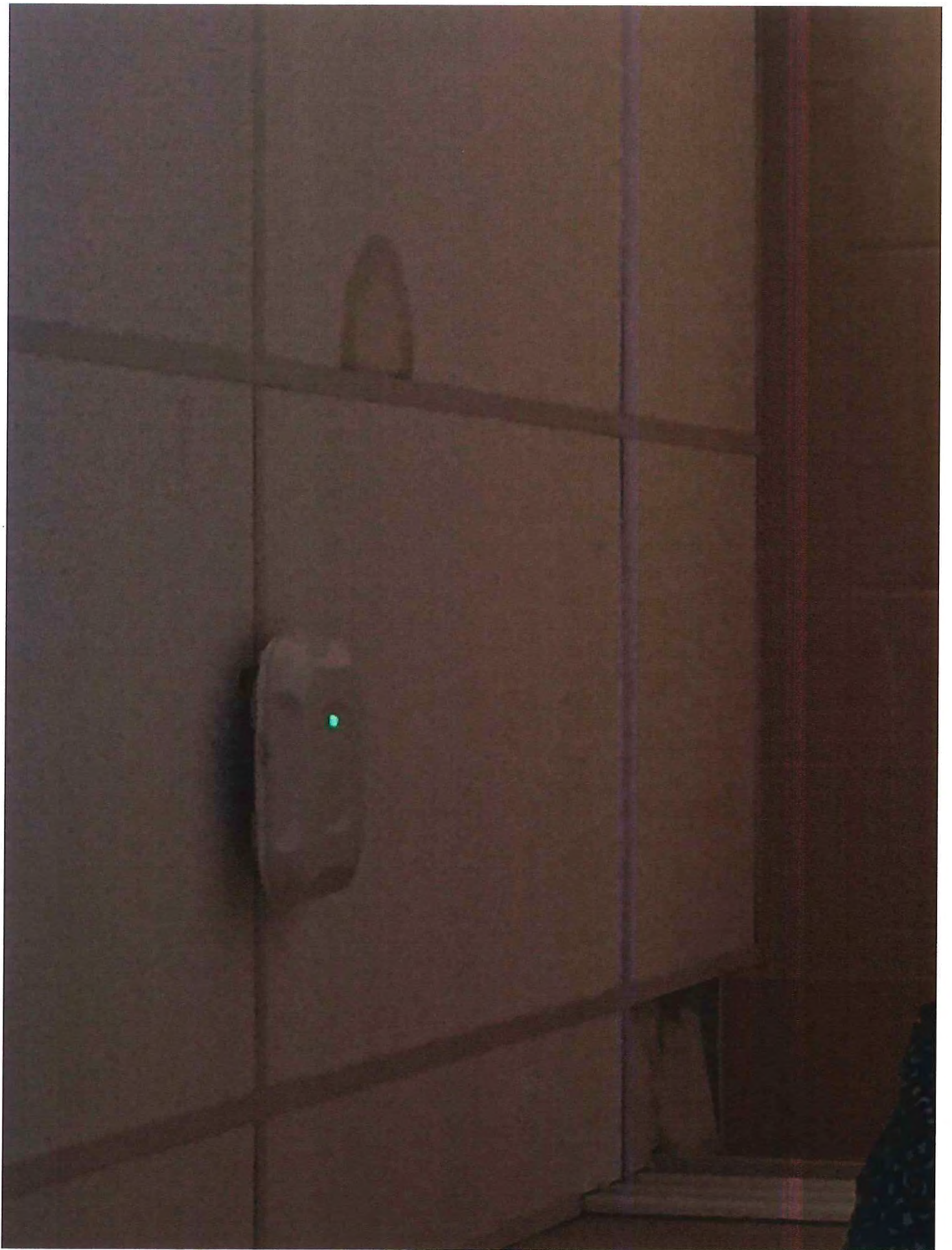












Thank you, Mister Speaker.
