How Laws Are Made

First Reading The bill is introduced and a brief explanation is provided without any debate.

Second Reading

Members debate the object or purpose of the bill, called the principle of the bill.

COMMITTEE STAGE The bill is examined clause by clause in a Committee of the Whole House in which all Members participate. The results of the Committe of the Whole house debate are reported to the Assembly.

Third Reading & Pass

Members debate the potential effect of the bill and vote on whether it should pass.

ROYALThe Lieutenant Governor assents to
the bill in the name of His Majesty the
King, at which point the bill becomes
law unless otherwise directed in the
bill itself.



The Assembly sits twice a year, once in the spring and once in the fall. The public is welcome to view the debates from the public galleries in the Chamber, on the right-hand side inside the door, and on the far left in front of the windows. Seating is limited, so be sure to arrive early!


