for a term of three years, starting July 9, 2018 and to expire on July 9, 2021.

2) That Ms. Deborah Gross be appointed to the Prince Edward Island Human Rights Commissioner for a term of three years, starting July 9, 2018 and to expire on July 9, 2021.
