FRIDAY, 14 JUNE 2019

The House met at 10:00 a.m.

Hon. Mr. Speaker took the Chair and welcomed all Hon. Members, staff of the Legislative Assembly, and guests to the official opening of the 1st Session of the 66th General Assembly.

On Motion of Hon. Premier, seconded by the Hon. Leader of the Opposition,

Hon. Mr. Speaker referenced communication from Her Honour yesterday, and indicated that it was his intention to leave the Chair in anticipation of Her Honour's arrival.
